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The Music of Africa series

consists of selections from the many thousands of recordings made by Dr. Hugh Tracey with the International Library of African Music over the last twenty-two years. It fills a less specialist need than the I.L.A.M.'s "Sound of Africa" Series and is designed rather for those with a general interest in Africa, whether musicians, visitors to Africa, or simply lovers of the richest music of any continent in the world.

The Series is published in coloured sleeves, each having a description of the contents on the back.

It is grouped in four ways: the African Music Society's Awards; Countries; Musical Instruments, and African Stories, to provide a selection for all tastes. For those wanting only a short introduction to African music we particularly recommend the first, the African Music Society's Awards, which give a cross-section of many types of music.

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
