

MESSAGE FROM THE VICE-CHANCELLOR

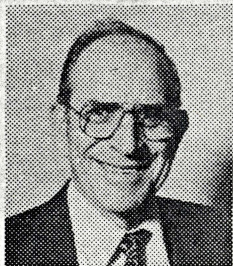
