SIDE 1

1. **LIONS** roaring in distance, approaching and nearby.
2. **SPOTTED HYENAS** in distance, and on the kill.

SIDE 2

1. **HIPPOPOTAMUS**, in river.
2. (a) **WHITE RHINOCEROS** at mud wallow, snorting with birds and crickets in the background.
(b) **BURCHELL'S ZEBRA** calling (repeated sounds like a small dog yelping).
3. **BUSH PIG**, approaching.
4. **CHACMA BABOON** calling.
5. **BLACKBACKED JACKAL** calling in distance and nearby, with crickets and other insects.
6. (a) **BLUE WILDEBEEST** honking in distance.
(b) **BURCHELL'S ZEBRA** sporting, with small birds and Hadedda Ibis

Items 1 and 2 on Side 1, and 1 and 3 on Side 2 were recorded by Clem Haagner. The others were recorded by Humphrey Gilbert.
