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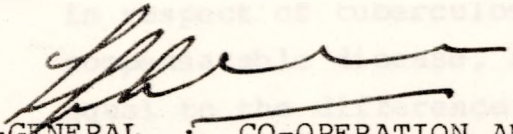
REPORT

OF THE BLACK AFFAIRS AUTHORITY IN RESPECT OF THE BLACK
COMPENSATION FUND ESTABLISHED IN TERMS OF SECTION 109 (2) OF
THE OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES IN MINES AND WORKS ACT, 1973 (ACT 78
OF 1973)

for the period 1 April 1979 to 31 March 1980.

LEGISLATION

1. In terms of section 109 (1) of the Occupational Diseases in Mines and Works Act, 1973 (Act 78 of 1973) which repealed the Pneumoconiosis Compensation Act, 1962 (Act 64 of 1962) as amended, the Black Affairs Authority, defined as the Director-General : Co-operation and Development, is charged with the payment of a benefit or any other amount awarded by the Compensation Commissioner for Occupational Diseases in terms of the Act, or the previous Act, to or in respect of a Black person.

COMPENSATION TO BLACK PERSONS

2. Benefits for compensatable diseases are awarded as follows by the Compensation Commissioner, after the certification committee has found that a Black person is suffering from a compensatable disease which he contracted as a result of employment at or in connection with a controlled mine or a controlled works:-
- (i) in the case of a compensatable disease other than tuberculosis if a benefit was not previously awarded, a one-sum benefit of R1 331;
 - (ii) in the case of tuberculosis together with any other compensatable disease, if a benefit was not previously awarded, a one-sum benefit of R1 598;
 - (iii) in the case where a benefit was previously awarded in respect of tuberculosis or any other compensatable disease, an additional one-sum benefit equal to the difference between R1 598 and the benefit previously awarded; and
 - (iv) in the case of tuberculosis with which the person concerned was in the opinion of the certification committee already affected while he was performing risk work, or at any time within twelve months as from the date on which he performed risk work if he had worked not less than 200 shifts and if a benefit was not previously awarded in respect of tuberculosis, a one-sum benefit of R799.

BENEFITS IN RESPECT OF DECEASED BLACK PERSONS

3. When the certification committee has found that a deceased Black person who performed risk work, at or in connection with a controlled mine or a controlled works, was at the time of his death suffering from a

compensatable disease in respect of which he would have been entitled to a benefit, had he not died, the Commissioner shall award benefits as follows:-

- (i) in the case of a compensatable disease other than tuberculosis, or of such other compensatable disease together with tuberculosis if the deceased did not before his death become entitled to a benefit, two thirds of the benefit to which he would have been entitled had he not died;
- (ii) in the case of tuberculosis, if he did not before his death become entitled to a benefit, one-half of the benefit to which the deceased would have been entitled had he not died;
- (iii) in the case of tuberculosis together with any other compensatable disease, if the deceased became entitled before his death to a benefit, two thirds of the additional benefit to which the deceased would have been entitled had he not died.

SPECIAL AWARD TO A BLACK PERSON

4. If a Black person within the Republic, to whom a benefit was awarded has been paid in full, and is in necessitous circumstances and unable, by reason of old age or continuous poor health, to earn sufficient means of subsistence, the Department may in its discretion, out of moneys in the Black Compensation Fund not required for the payment of benefits under this Act, make special awards to such person. Special awards have been increased from R285 to R330 with effect from 1 October 1979. Moneys not required for the payment of benefits consist of unpaid benefits in respect of which the beneficiary after a period of 24 months made no withdrawals and can not be traced.

PAYMENT OF BENEFITS

5. Benefits are paid as follows to or on behalf of beneficiaries:-

- (a) Blacks inside the Republic - mainly in bi-monthly instalments of R55-00, and in certain circumstances, partly in a one-sum and partly in bi-monthly instalments of R55-00
- (b) Blacks outside the Republic - In a single payment to the beneficiary or to the representative of the country of origin.

UNCLAIMED BENEFITS

9. Benefits in respect of Blacks who have after a lapse of two years not yet claimed their awards and who cannot be traced, are credited to an unclaimed benefits account from which special awards are made in terms of Section 115 of the Act. On 31 March 1980 the balance in this account amounted to R5 351 048. Payment of benefits is reinstated when a beneficiary or his dependants are traced.

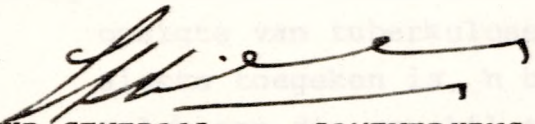

WETGEWING

1. Kragtens artikel 109 (1) van die Wet op Bedryfsiektes in Myne en Bedrywe, 1973 (Wet 78 van 1973), wat die Pneumokoniose-vergoedingswet, 1962 (Wet 64 van 1962), soos gewysig, herroep het, is die Swart sake-owerheid, omskryf as die Direkteur-generaal : Samewerking en Ontwikkeling, belas met die betaling van 'n voordeel of ander bedrag, wat ingevolge die Wet of die vorige Wet, aan of ten opsigte van 'n Swart persoon deur die Vergoedingskommissaris vir Bedryfsiektes toegeken is.

VERGOEDING AAN SWART PERSONE

2. Voordele vir vergoedbare siektes word soos volg deur die Vergoedingskommissaris toegeken nadat die sertifiseringskomitee bevind het dat 'n Swart persoon aan 'n vergoedbare siekte ly wat hy opgedoen het as gevolg van sy werk by of in verband met 'n beheerde bedryf:
- (i) in die geval van 'n ander vergoedbare siekte as tuberkulose, indien daar nie voorheen 'n voordeel toegeken is nie, 'n enkelbedragvoordeel van R1 331;
 - (ii) in die geval van tuberkulose saam met 'n ander vergoedbare siekte, indien daar nog nie voorheen 'n voordeel toegeken is nie, 'n enkelbedragvoordeel van R1 598;
 - (iii) in die geval waar daar voorheen 'n voordeel ten opsigte van tuberkulose of 'n ander vergoedbare siekte toegeken is, 'n bykomende enkelbedragvoordeel gelyk aan die verskil tussen R1 598 en die voordeel wat voorheen toegeken is; en
 - (iv) in die geval van tuberkulose waardeur die betrokke persoon volgens die sertifiseringskomitee se oordeel reeds aangetas was, terwyl hy risikowerk verrig het, of te eniger tyd binne twaalf maande van die datum waarop hy die laaste keer risikowerk verrig het indien hy minstens 200 skofte gewerk het, en indien daar nie voorheen 'n voordeel ten opsigte van tuberkulose toegeken is nie, 'n enkelbedragvoordeel van R799.

VOORDELE TEN OPSIGTE VAN OORLEDE SWART PERSONE

3. Wanneer die sertifiseringskomitee bevind dat 'n oorlede Swart persoon, wat risikowerk by of in verband met 'n beheerde myn of 'n beheerde bedryf verrig het, ten tye van

sy dood aan 'n vergoedbare siekte gely het ten opsigte waarvan hy op 'n voordeel geregtig sou gewees het indien hy nie gesterf het nie, ken die Vergoedingskommissaris voordele soos volg toe:-

- (i) in die geval van 'n ander vergoedbare siekte as tuberkulose, indien die oorledene nie voor sy dood op 'n voordeel geregtig geword het nie, tweederdes van die voordeel waarop hy geregtig sou gewees het indien hy nie gesterf het nie;
- (ii) in die geval van tuberkulose, indien hy nie voor sy dood op 'n voordeel geregtig geword het nie, die helfte van die voordeel waarop die oorledene geregtig sou gewees het indien hy nie gesterf het nie;
- (iii) in die geval van tuberkulose saam met 'n ander vergoedbare siekte, indien die oorledene voor sy dood op 'n voordeel geregtig geword het, tweederdes van die bykomende voordeel waarop die oorledene geregtig sou gewees het indien hy nie gesterf het nie.

SPESIALE TOEKENNING AAN 'n SWART PERSOON

4. Indien 'n Republiek Swart persoon, aan wie 'n voordeel toegeken is, ten volle betaal is, in behoeftige omstandighede verkeer en weens ouderdom of swak gesondheid nie in staat is om voldoende lewensmiddele te verdien nie, kan die Departement na goeddunke uit gelde in die Swart Vergoedingsfonds wat nie vir betaling van voordele ingevolge die Wet nodig is nie, aan die betrokke persoon spesiale toekennings maak. Spesiale toekennings is met ingang van 1 Oktober 1979 van R285 na R330 verhoog. Gelde wat nie vir betaling van voordele nodig is nie, bestaan

uit onuitbetaalde voordele ten opsigte waarvan die begunstigde na verloop van 24 maande nog nie enige opvragings gedoen het en nie gespoor kan word nie.

UITBETALING VAN VOORDELE

5. Voordele word soos volg aan of ten behoeve van begunstigdes betaal:-

(a) Republiek-Swartes - Hoofsaaklik in paaieimente van R55-00 elke tweede maand en in sekere omstandighede gedeeltelik in 'n enkele bedrag en in tweemaandelikse paaieimente van R55-00.

(b) Swartes buite die Republiek - In 'n enkele bedrag aan die begunstigde of aan die verteenwoordiger van die land van herkoms.
