MR XYPTERAS HAD COME TO 'SELL' ME THE IDEA OF A STUDENT RADIO STATION AT RHODES, ND SELL IT HE DID.' THE UNIVERSITY GRANTED THE VENTURE SOME FINANCIAL SUPPORT AND A ROOM IN THE UNION BUILDING AND RHODES MUSIC RADIO (RMR), WAS BORN IN AUGUST 1980.

SINCE ITS BEGINNING WITH A FIVE-MEMBER COMMITTEE AND A SECOND HAND HI-FI SET PLAYING MUSIC IN AIF, RMR HAS GROWN INTO A MOST SUCCESSFUL COMMUNITY RADIO STATION. IN THIS REGARD IT IS A PLEASURE TO HAVE WITH US ON THIS OCCASION, MANY OF THE PEOPLE WHO HAVE BEEN INSTRUMENTAL IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RMR. TO YOU ALL, ADVERTISERS, SPONSORS, RADIO STATIONS, RECORD COMPANIES, EQUIPMENT SUPPLIERS AND MANY OTHERS, ON BEHALF OF RHODES UNIVERSITY AND RHODES MUSIC RADIO, I EXTEND OUR VERY SINCERE THANKS FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE.
