SCOPE and CONTENT

The Henderson Papers comprise archival documents that were collected over the years by Dr. Thelma Muriel Henderson (1933 – 2009) and her husband Dr. Derek Scott Henderson (1929 – 2009) and relate to their involvement in University administration in the United States of America and South Africa. The bulk of the collection relates to their work at Rhodes University and in particular Thelma Henderson's extensive work in social upliftment in Grahamstown.

The collection is divided into series, namely: 1) Speeches delivered by Thelma Henderson and Derek Henderson, 2) Thelma Henderson's Master's degree **Social Development: Theory, Practice and Evaluation**, 3) Records relating to the management of St. Peter Clavers Nursery School (formerly known as Fingo Village Nursery School).
